

1. Uranium will be shipped to Russia for enrichment, and then fabricated into fuel rods in France for shipment back to Iran.

Turkey

will be the designated country for holding the material in escrow.

2. Iran will completely suspend uranium enrichment for the next two

years, and talks will resume on this issue at the end of this period.

3. Russia and China will inspect Iranian nuclear facilities regularly, and

provide all inspection reports to the IAEA.

4. Iran will send all of its centrifuges at Natanz and Qom to Pakistan as part of an agreement between those two countries.

5. Russia and France will fully support the immediate lifting of UN sanctions on Iran in return for continued compliance with this agreement.
