

To the Delegation of the United States of America:

As you well know, you are representing the United States of America, the world's greatest and most powerful democracy. You will do whatever is necessary to protect the American people, support our allies, and to promote the spread of freedom and security. The United States must ensure hegemonic control throughout the conference by holding itself to the highest standards of intelligence gathering.

The following is a list of the United States' primary objectives for these negotiations:

1. The complete and verifiable freeze and dismantling of all aspects of the nuclear program in Iran. In the short term, this includes at a bare minimum compliance with the Additional Protocol as well as stopping uranium enrichment and construction of a heavy-water reactor. Iran has clearly violated the nonproliferation treaty and must be made an example of or further proliferation will occur. Make clear to Iran, the UK, France, Russia, and China that the United States supports a diplomatic solution to this problem, but if diplomacy is unproductive there are other ways to enforce treaty commitments. The use of the phrase "we will take no options off the table" is encouraged.
2. From the Russian delegation: Demand Russian support for economic sanctions against the government of Iran if the conference is unsuccessful. Assure the Russians that we will have more flexibility in negotiations on the issue of missile defense after the election.
3. From the Israeli delegation: Obtain a promise that they will not take military action against Iran without our permission. Privately condemn their threats to do so. Publicly state that Israel has a right to defend its territory, and reestablish deterrence in the region.
4. From the French and UK delegations: Demand clear red lines for their negotiations with the Iranians, and obtain their backing for military action in the event that those red lines are crossed.
5. North Korea has pushed up its satellite "launch." Do everything in your power to ensure the launch does not happen. This display of rocket technology will severely damage the non-proliferation regime if it comes to fruition. Instate further sanctions on North Korea if they refuse to cancel the launch. Remind the North Korean delegation that without a fecund monster rabbit population, the loss of US food aid will be devastating.
6. Demand that China, India, and Pakistan join the Proliferation Security Initiative. This will strengthen our ability to prevent further proliferation of nuclear weapons.

In pursuing these objectives:

1. No mention of Israel's nuclear program
2. No agreement by the US to any restraint on our ability to maintain a safe, secure, and effective nuclear deterrent.
3. For those who join and faithfully uphold the Proliferation Security Initiative – economic incentives.

One further word, any US delegate speaking the word "nucUlar", instead of "nuclear", will be immediately replaced. This is not the Bush Administration.
