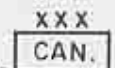

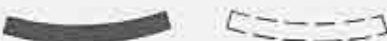

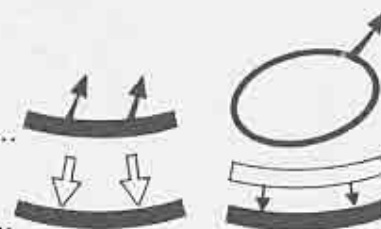

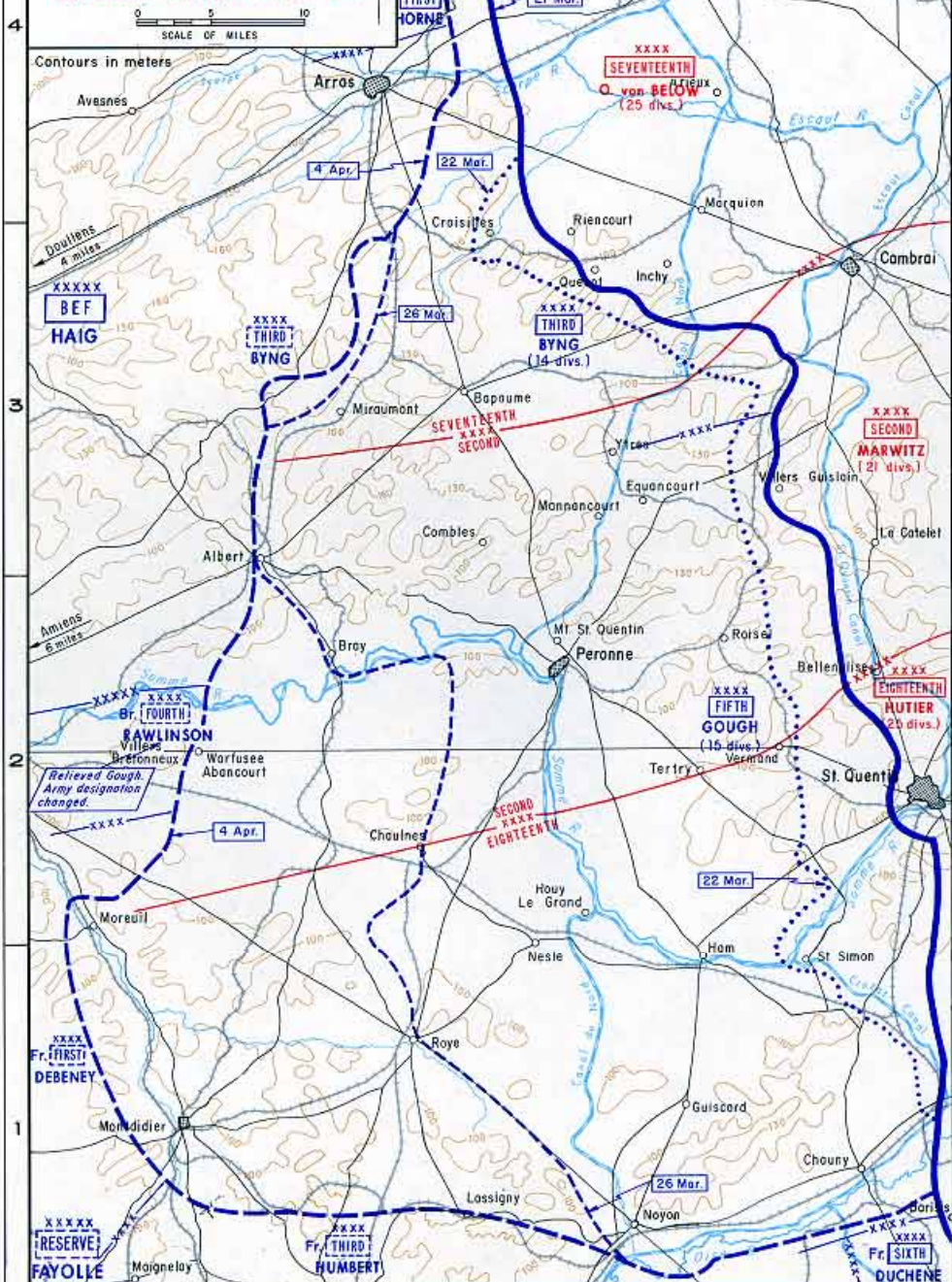




PERONNE, FRANCE AND VICINITY
