Alex: Is there any truth to the critique that Biddle's definition of technology is too narrow? How would you define the role of technology in Biddle's modern system?

Galen: Has there been a revolution in how warfare is conducted and the determinants of success within our lifetimes?

Allen: What is Biddle really claiming, and how are his claims *really* different from previous theory? To what extent is Biddle's modern system flexibility just a larger RMA disaggregated into a series of small RMAs? How could the modern system be considered an RMA in itself?
