EXAM 1 REVISIONS

You can regain full credit for up to two problems from Exam 2 in the following manner: For one problem, you may submit a revised solution. For another problem, you can undertake the following process:

- (a) Identify the mistake you made on the problem.
- (b) Identify the important concepts examined or used in the problem.
- (c) Find or create a question of similar difficulty which engages with the same concepts; clearly state this question.
- (d) Solve your question.
- (e) Turn in parts (a)-(d).

You are welcome to consult with the instructor and textbooks during the revision process, but not with other students or tutors. For the second “metacognitive” revision, **you may not select a question if you have accessed its solution (in print, on the Internet, or in some other form)**. Cite any sources used.
