

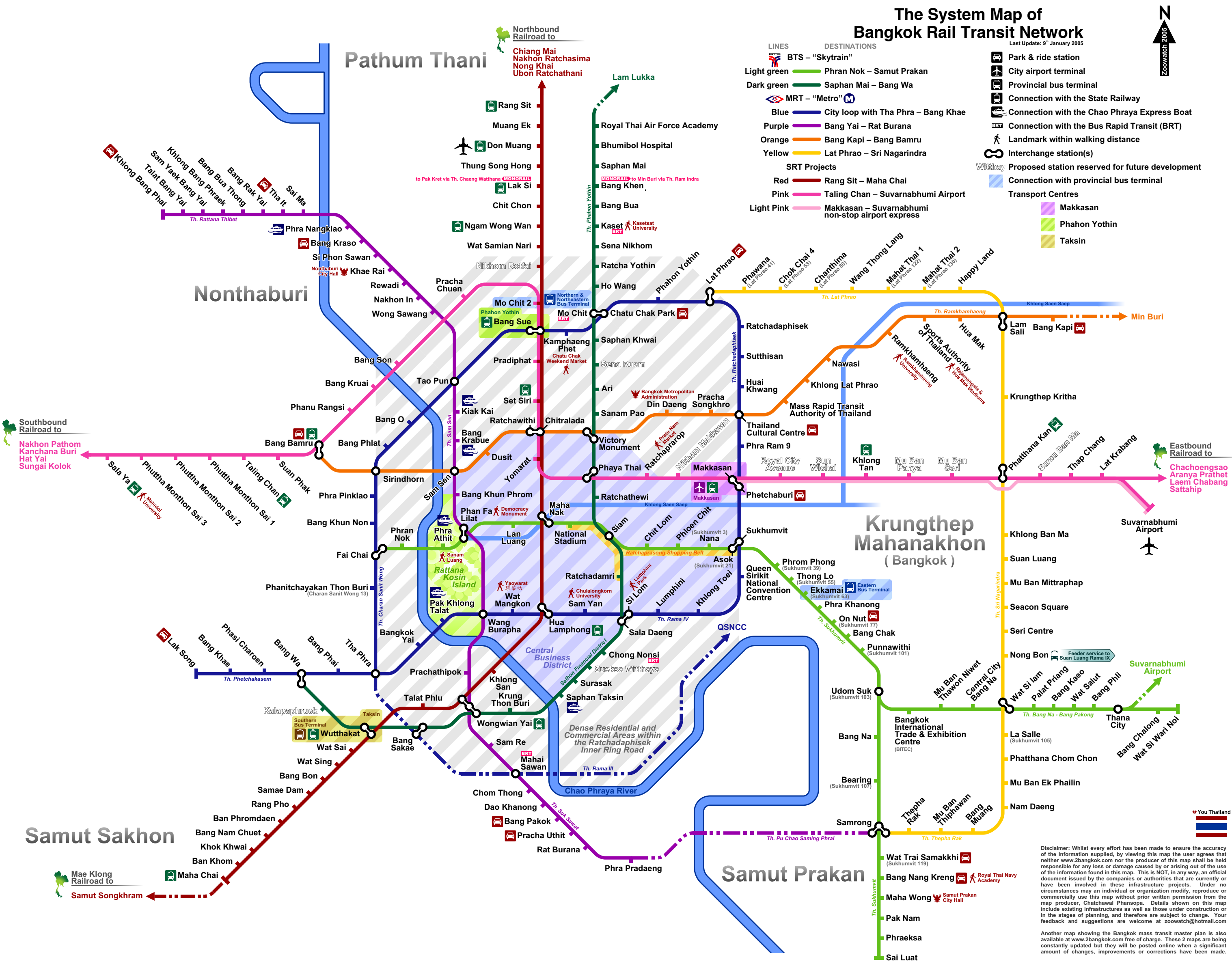
# The System Map of Bangkok Rail Transit Network
